WHAT DOES CASH TIME DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and income ■ account transactions and payment history ■ credit history and transaction or loss history
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Cash Time chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Cash Time companies and affiliates that provide financial products or services, including Cash Time Title Loans, Inc., Cash Time Financial Services, LLC, Cash Time Loan Centers CA, LLC, Cash Time Loan Centers, LCC, and DiscountRateLoans.com, LLC.
What we do	
How does Cash Time protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Cash Time collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ open an account or give us your income information ■ provide employment information or apply for a loan ■ give us your contact information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, and other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more information on your rights under state law.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Our affiliates include financial companies such as Cash Time Title Loans, Inc., Cash Time Financial Services, LLC, Cash Time Loan Centers CA, LLC, Cash Time Loan Centers, LCC, and DiscountRateLoans.com, LLC; and nonfinancial companies such as Arizona Motor Vehicle Title Service, Inc.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Cash Time does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Cash Time does not jointly market.</i>
Other important information	
California: We will not share information we collect about you with affiliated or non-affiliated third parties, except in the limited circumstances permitted under state law, or if you give us permission.
